## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) A state employee who is a certified disaster
- 2 service volunteer of the American red cross may be granted leave
- 3 from work with pay for not to exceed 30 work days in each year to
- 4 participate in specialized disaster relief services for the
- 5 American red cross, upon the request of the American red cross
- 6 for the services of that employee and upon approval of the agency
- 7 that employs the employee.
- 8 (2) An employee granted leave under this section shall be
- 9 compensated at his or her regular rate of pay for those regular
- 10 work hours during which the employee is absent from work and
- 11 shall not lose vacation leave, sick leave, or other fringe
- 12 benefits except as otherwise provided in this section.
