

# HOUSE BILL No. 5555

February 10, 1998, Introduced by Reps. Profit, Cropsey, Wetters, Lowe, McNutt, Llewellyn, Curtis, McBryde, Middaugh, Gernaat, Nye, DeHart, Horton, Middleton, Kukuk, Schauer, Walberg, Wojno, Kaza, Frank, Jelinek, Dobb, Dalman, London, Rocca, Prusi, Gustafson, Hanley, Birkholz, Tesanovich, Hammerstrom, Jellema, Law, DeVuyst, Jansen, Sikkema, McManus, Crissman, Leland, Rhead, Whyman, Owen, Baade, Galloway, Alley, Cassis, Bodem, Green, Goschka, Varga, Voorhees, Perricone, Callahan, Oxender, Vaughn, Harder, Cherry, Schermesser, Basham, Mans, Freeman and Olshove and referred to the Committee on House Oversight and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms possessed in violation of this act; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act,"

(MCL 28.421 to 28.434) by adding section 5m; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 5M. A LICENSE TO CARRY A CONCEALED PISTOL IS VALID FOR  
2 3 YEARS, AND MAY BE RENEWED IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE ORIGINAL  
3 LICENSE WAS RECEIVED, EXCEPT AS FOLLOWS:

4        (A) THE RENEWAL FEE IS \$35.00. THE FEE SHALL BE PAYABLE TO  
5 THE COUNTY. THE COUNTY TREASURER SHALL DEPOSIT THE FEE IN THE  
6 GENERAL FUND OF THE COUNTY. AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A RETIRED

1 POLICE OFFICER OF A POLICE AGENCY OF THIS STATE OR OF A POLITICAL  
2 SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE WHO PRESENTS EVIDENCE SATISFACTORY TO  
3 THE CONCEALED WEAPON LICENSING BOARD OF HIS OR HER STATUS AS A  
4 RETIRED POLICE OFFICER OF THIS STATE OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION  
5 OF THIS STATE IS NOT REQUIRED TO PAY A RENEWAL FEE UNDER THIS  
6 SECTION.

7 (B) FINGERPRINTS ARE NOT REQUIRED FOR A RENEWAL.

8 (C) THE EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 5B(8)(J) ARE  
9 WAIVED EXCEPT THAT THE APPLICANT SHALL PRESENT EVIDENCE SATISFAC-  
10 TORY TO THE BOARD THAT HE OR SHE HAS COMPLETED NOT LESS THAN 3  
11 HOURS OF REVIEW OF THE TRAINING DESCRIBED UNDER SECTION 5B(8)(J)  
12 SINCE RECEIVING HIS OR HER LICENSE, AND THAT TRAINING INCLUDED  
13 FIRING RANGE TIME IN THE 6 MONTHS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING HIS OR  
14 HER RENEWAL APPLICATION.

15 Enacting section 1. Section 12c of 1927 PA 372, MCL  
16 28.432c, is repealed.

17 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect  
18 January 1, 1999.

19 Enacting section 3. This amendatory act does not take  
20 effect unless all of the following bills of the 89th Legislature  
21 are enacted into law:
