

**SENATE BILL NO. 943**

February 26, 1998, Introduced by Senator STILLE and referred to the Committee on Families, Mental Health and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act," (MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 57i.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 57I. UNLESS FEDERAL LAW OR OTHER STATE LAW REQUIRES  
2 OTHERWISE, A PERSON WHO IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE BUT NOT OLDER  
3 THAN 50 YEARS OF AGE, AND WHO IS NOT EXEMPT FROM PARTICIPATION IN  
4 WORK FIRST UNDER SECTION 57F(3), IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FOOD  
5 STAMPS UNDER THIS ACT FOR MORE THAN 3 MONTHS IN ANY 36-MONTH  
6 PERIOD UNLESS THAT PERSON MEETS 1 OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:  
7           (A) PERFORMS AT LEAST 25 HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK  
8 ACTIVITIES DURING EACH CONSECUTIVE 30-DAY PERIOD.  
9           (B) WORKS AT LEAST 80 HOURS OR MORE DURING EACH CONSECUTIVE  
10 30-DAY PERIOD.

1 (C) PARTICIPATES IN A WORK PROGRAM FOR AT LEAST 80 HOURS  
2 DURING EACH CONSECUTIVE 30-DAY PERIOD.
