

SENATE BILL NO. 948

February 26, 1998, Introduced by Senator BENNETT and
referred to the Committee on Gaming and Casino Oversight.

A bill to amend the Initiated Law of 1996, entitled
"Michigan gaming control and revenue act,"
(MCL 432.201 to 432.226) by adding section 11a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 11A. (1) A CASINO LICENSEE SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD EACH
2 TIME A PERSON WINS \$1,000.00 OR MORE IN THE COURSE OF A SINGLE
3 WAGER OR GAME AT THE LICENSEE'S CASINO.

4 (2) THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL INCLUDE
5 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

6 (A) THE NAME, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, BIRTH DATE, AND
7 ADDRESS OF THE PERSON.

8 (B) THE AMOUNT OF MONEY WON BY THE PERSON.

9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
10 effect unless Senate Bill No. 947

1 of the 89th Legislature is
2 enacted into law.
