

SENATE BILL NO. 1232

September 15, 1998, Introduced by Senator KOIVISTO and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code," (MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 479c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 479C. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

2 (A) INTENTIONALLY RESIST AN INDIVIDUAL HE OR SHE KNOWS OR
3 HAS REASON TO KNOW IS A COURT OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE PERFORMING HIS
4 OR HER DUTIES AS A COURT OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE.

5 (B) INTENTIONALLY OBSTRUCT AN INDIVIDUAL HE OR SHE KNOWS OR
6 HAS REASON TO KNOW IS A COURT OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE FROM PERFORMING
7 HIS OR HER DUTIES AS A COURT OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE.

8 (C) ASSAULT OR BATTER AN INDIVIDUAL HE OR SHE KNOWS OR HAS
9 REASON TO KNOW IS A COURT OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE PERFORMING HIS OR
10 HER DUTIES AS A COURT OFFICER OR EMPLOYER, OR BECAUSE OF HIS OR
11 HER STATUS AS A COURT OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE.

1 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
2 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS
3 OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.
