## ANTI-LISTERIA PROGRAM

## A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 4914 and 4915 AS INTRODUCED 9-29-99

The bills would require meat processors and meat product manufacturers to implement antilisteria programs by January 1, 2002. More specifically, <u>House Bill 4914</u> would amend the Food Processing Act of 1977 (MCL 289.805) and <u>House Bill 4915</u> (MCL 289.588) would amend the Michigan Comminuted Meat Law, respectively, to require the Department of Agriculture to promulgate rules requiring the establishment of an anti-listeria program not later than January 1, 2002, to include at least irradiation and pasteurization.
