CONTENT

<u>Senate Bill 1081</u> would amend Section 297e of the Michigan Penal Code to remove a provision that allows the Department of Agriculture to promulgate rules and regulations regarding the labeling of kosher foods.

<u>Senate Bill 1082</u> would amend Public Act 184 of 1913, which regulates sales of farm products by commission merchants (who sell farm produce on commission), to replace references to the "state dairy and food commissioner" with references to the Director of the Department of Agriculture.
