ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5028

AN ACT to designate the part of highway I-75 located in Monroe county as the "Medal of Honor Recipient and American Legion Memorial Highway"; and to prescribe certain duties of the state transportation department.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 1. The part of highway I-75 located in Monroe county shall be known as the "Medal of Honor Recipient and American Legion Memorial Highway".

Sec. 2. The state transportation department shall only provide for the erection of suitable markers at the approach to the part of the highway described in section 1 when sufficient private contributions are received to pay the cost of erecting those markers.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
