THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1304. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF
- 2 DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE THAT THE NUMBER
- 3 OF SPECIAL EDUCATION PUPILS ASSIGNED TO A TEACHER IN A GENERAL
- 4 EDUCATION CLASSROOM DOES NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF SPECIAL
- 5 EDUCATION PUPILS ALLOWED TO BE ASSIGNED TO A TEACHER IN A SPECIAL
- 6 EDUCATION CLASSROOM IN THAT SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 7 ACADEMY.
- 8 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SPECIAL EDUCATION PUPIL" MEANS
- 9 A PUPIL WHO RECEIVES SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES.
