

HOUSE BILL No. 4570

April 27, 1999, Introduced by Reps. Baird, Brater, Schauer, Schermesser, Martinez, Mans, DeHart, Dennis and Woodward and referred to the Committee on Conservation and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 12102.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 12102. NOT LATER THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE
2 OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPART-
3 MENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
4 (A) IDENTIFY ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTANTS COMMONLY USED OR FOUND
5 IN AREAS THAT ARE REASONABLY ACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN.
6 (B) UTILIZING SCIENTIFIC PEER REVIEW, DEVELOP A LIST OF
7 ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTANTS IDENTIFIED UNDER SUBDIVISION (A) WITH
8 KNOWN, LIKELY, OR SUSPECTED HEALTH RISKS TO CHILDREN.
9 (C) DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS TO HELP REDUCE OR ELIMINATE
10 EXPOSURE OF CHILDREN TO ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTANTS LISTED UNDER
11 SUBDIVISION (B) IN AREAS REASONABLY ACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN. IF

1 THE LIST UNDER SUBDIVISION (B) INCLUDES PESTICIDES, THE
2 RECOMMENDATION SHALL INCLUDE ADVICE, DEVELOPED IN CONSULTATION
3 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, ON HOW TO ESTABLISH AN INTE-
4 GRATED PEST MANAGEMENT PROGRAM THAT REDUCES OR ELIMINATES EXPO-
5 SURE OF CHILDREN TO THOSE PESTICIDES.

6 (D) DISTRIBUTE INFORMATION BASED ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS
7 UNDER SUBDIVISION (C) ADVISING PARENTS ON HOW TO PROTECT CHILDREN
8 FROM EXPOSURE TO ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTANTS.
