(MCL 205.51 to 205.78) by adding section 4r.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 4R. A PERSON SUBJECT TO TAX UNDER THIS ACT MAY EXCLUDE
2 FROM THE GROSS PROCEEDS USED FOR THE COMPUTATION OF THIS TAX THE
3 SALE OF A TEXTBOOK REQUIRED FOR TAKING A COURSE AT AN INSTITUTION
4 OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION.
