

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4851**

September 23, 1999, Introduced by Reps. Richner, Law, DeWeese, Ehardt, Julian, Daniels and Schauer and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 10103a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 10103A. (1) IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES
- 2 EXIST, THE FEDERALLY DESIGNATED ORGAN PROCUREMENT ORGANIZATION
- 3 OPERATING IN THIS STATE SHALL COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (2):
- 4 (A) A GIFT OF A VASCULAR ORGAN IS MADE UNDER THIS PART WITH-
- 5 OUT SPECIFYING A DONEE OR A SPECIFIED DONEE REJECTS A GIFT OF A
- 6 VASCULAR ORGAN MADE TO THAT DONEE UNDER THIS PART.
- 7 (B) THE FEDERALLY DESIGNATED ORGAN PROCUREMENT AGENCY HAS
- 8 JURISDICTION OVER THE ALLOCATION OF THE GIFT DESCRIBED IN SUBDI-
- 9 VISION (A).
- 10 (C) A SPECIFIED DONEE IN ANOTHER STATE DOES NOT EXIST AS A
- 11 RESULT OF A RECIPROCAL ORGAN-SHARING ARRANGEMENT WITH A FEDERALLY

- 3 (2) THE FEDERALLY DESIGNATED ORGAN PROCUREMENT AGENCY
- 4 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) SHALL ATTEMPT TO FIND A SUITABLE
- 5 DONEE IN THIS STATE BEFORE OFFERING THE VASCULAR ORGAN TO A DONEE
- 6 IN ANOTHER STATE.
- 7 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 8 (A) "FEDERALLY DESIGNATED ORGAN PROCUREMENT ORGANIZATION"
- 9 MEANS AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS DESIGNATED BY THE UNITED STATES
- 10 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, HEALTH CARE FINANCING
- 11 ADMINISTRATION OR ITS SUCCESSOR, TO PERFORM OR COORDINATE THE
- 12 PERFORMANCE OF SURGICAL RECOVERY, PRESERVATION, AND TRANSPORTA-
- 13 TION OF HUMAN ORGANS, AND THAT MAINTAINS A SYSTEM FOR LOCATING
- 14 PROSPECTIVE RECIPIENTS FOR AVAILABLE ORGANS.
- 15 (B) "RECIPROCAL ORGAN-SHARING AGREEMENT" MEANS AN AGREEMENT
- 16 WITH A QUALIFIED FEDERALLY DESIGNATED ORGAN PROCUREMENT ORGANIZA-
- 17 TION OPERATING IN ANOTHER STATE, THE PURPOSE OF WHICH AGREEMENT
- 18 IS TO SERVE THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF
- 19 MICHIGAN.
- 20 (C) "VASCULAR ORGAN" MEANS THE HEART, LUNGS, KIDNEYS, LIVER,
- 21 PANCREAS, INTESTINE, OR ANY OTHER ORGAN THAT REQUIRES THE CONTIN-
- 22 UOUS CIRCULATION OF BLOOD TO REMAIN USEFUL FOR TRANSPLANTATION
- 23 PURPOSES. AS USED IN THIS PART, VASCULAR ORGAN DOES NOT INCLUDE
- 24 HUMAN TISSUE, BONES, OR CORNEAS.
