



# HOUSE BILL No. 5131

November 10, 1999, Introduced by Rep. LaSata and referred to the Committee on Constitutional Law and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled  
"Occupational code,"  
(MCL 339.101 to 339.2721) by adding article 17A.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

### ARTICLE 17A

SEC. 1766. (1) AN ADULT ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT SHALL  
NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT IN WRITING WITHIN 10 DAYS IF ANY INFORMA-  
TION IT HAS PROVIDED IN ITS APPLICATION HAS CHANGED. IF THE  
CHANGE IS TO DISCLOSE THE IDENTITY OF A NATURAL PERSON ABOUT WHOM  
THE ADULT ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE  
INFORMATION IN ITS APPLICATION UNDER SECTION 1759, THE ADULT  
ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT SHALL INCLUDE IN THE NOTICE THE FULL  
NAME, INCLUDING NICKNAMES OR ALIASES, RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS, PLACE  
OF EMPLOYMENT INCLUDING ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE NUMBER, DATE OF

1 BIRTH, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, DRIVER LICENSE NUMBER, AND A  
2 PHOTOGRAPH TAKEN WITHIN 30 DAYS OF APPLICATION OF THE PERSON.

3 (2) IN ADDITION TO ANY PENALTIES ASSESSED UNDER ARTICLE 6, A  
4 VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY A FINE  
5 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000.00.

6 SEC. 1767. (1) THIS ARTICLE APPLIES TO ALL BUSINESSES AND  
7 ENTERPRISES SUBJECT TO THIS ARTICLE WHETHER IN EXISTENCE PRIOR  
8 TO, ON, OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ARTICLE.

9 (2) ISSUANCE OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE IS NOT A  
10 DEFENSE TO A CIVIL OR CRIMINAL ACTION OTHER THAN AN ACTION FOR A  
11 LICENSING VIOLATION UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

12 SEC. 1768. THE PREMISES AT WHICH THE BUSINESS OF A MASSAGE  
13 ESTABLISHMENT IS CARRIED ON SHALL, UPON REASONABLE NOTICE, BE  
14 SUBJECT TO PERIODIC INSPECTION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY  
15 HEALTH FOR THE PREVENTION OF THE SPREAD OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASES  
16 AND TO INSPECTION BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS.

17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
