



HOUSE BILL No. 5353

February 15, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Jansen, Julian, Birkholz, Spade, Rocca, Voorhees, DeWeese, Price, Green, Gosselin and Scott and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 811d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 811D. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP AND,
2 UPON APPLICATION, MAY ISSUE A HABITAT FOR HUMANITY PLATE TO AN
3 APPLICANT FOR USE ON THE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLE, PICKUP TRUCK,
4 VAN, MOTOR HOME, HEARSE, BUS, TRAILER COACH, OR TRAILER FOR WHICH
5 THE REGISTRATION PLATE IS ISSUED INSTEAD OF A STANDARD REGISTRA-
6 TION PLATE. HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REGISTRATION PLATES SHALL BEAR
7 LETTERS AND NUMBERS THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE PRESCRIBES. THE
8 PLATE SHALL BE OF A DESIGN AS DETERMINED BY THE SECRETARY OF
9 STATE. THE WORD "MICHIGAN" SHALL APPEAR ON EACH HABITAT FOR
10 HUMANITY REGISTRATION PLATE.

1 (2) AN APPLICATION FOR A HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REGISTRATION
2 PLATE SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE PURSUANT TO
3 THE PROCEDURES PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 217. APPLICATION FOR AN
4 ORIGINAL OR RENEWAL HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REGISTRATION PLATE SHALL
5 BE ACCOMPANIED WITH PAYMENT OF THE REGULAR VEHICLE REGISTRATION
6 TAX IN ADDITION TO A SERVICE FEE OF \$25.00.

7 (3) A HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REGISTRATION PLATE SHALL EXPIRE
8 AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 226. UPON THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF A
9 HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REGISTRATION PLATE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE
10 MAY ISSUE A TAB OR TABS DESIGNATING THE MONTH AND YEAR OF
11 EXPIRATION.

12 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE MAY ISSUE A TEMPORARY REGISTRA-
13 TION PERMIT TO A PERSON WHO SUBMITS AN APPLICATION AND THE PROPER
14 PAYMENTS FOR A HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REGISTRATION PLATE IF THE
15 APPLICANT'S CURRENT VEHICLE REGISTRATION WILL EXPIRE BEFORE HIS
16 OR HER RECEIPT OF A HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REGISTRATION PLATE. THE
17 TEMPORARY REGISTRATION SHALL EXPIRE UPON RECEIPT OF A HABITAT FOR
18 HUMANITY REGISTRATION PLATE OR 60 DAYS AFTER THE ISSUANCE OF A
19 HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REGISTRATION PLATE, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.
20 THE TEMPORARY PERMIT SHALL BE ISSUED WITHOUT A SEPARATE FEE.

21 (5) HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REGISTRATION PLATE SERVICE FEES
22 COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL BE
23 IDENTIFIED AND SEGREGATED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE INTO A SEPA-
24 RATE ACCOUNT. AFTER DEDUCTING THE MANUFACTURING AND ADMINISTRA-
25 TIVE COSTS OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE, INCLUDING ADMINISTRATIVE
26 COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH ISSUING, REPLACING, AND SUBSTITUTING
27 PLATES, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ON A QUARTERLY BASIS

1 TRANSFER THE BALANCE OF THE HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REGISTRATION
2 PLATE SERVICE FEES TO HABITAT FOR HUMANITY.

3 (6) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "HABITAT FOR HUMANITY REG-
4 ISTRATION PLATE" MEANS A REGISTRATION PLATE CONTAINING THE WORDS
5 "HABITAT FOR HUMANITY".
