

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5867**

June 1, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Kuipers, Scranton, Pappageorge, Julian, DeHart, Schermesser, Stamas and Birkholz and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 160c.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 160C. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT CONCEAL THE BODY OF A
- 2 DECEDENT FROM EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL.
- 4 (B) A MEDICAL EXAMINER.
- 5 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A
- 6 FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 YEARS, A
- 7 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 8 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DECEDENT" MEANS A DEAD HUMAN
- 9 BEING.
