- 8 summons and complaint in good faith are placed in the hands of an
- 9 officer for immediate service, but in this case the statute is

- 1 not tolled longer than 90 days after the copy of the summons and
- 2 complaint is received by the officer.
- **3** (d) If, during the applicable notice period under section
- 4 2912b, a claim would be barred by the statute of limitations or
- 5 repose, for not longer than a number of days equal to the number
- 6 of days in the applicable notice period after the date notice is
- 7 given in compliance with section 2912b.
- 8 (E) IF THE DEFENDANT AGAINST WHOM THE COMPLAINT WILL BE
- 9 FILED IS ALSO A DEFENDANT IN A CRIMINAL CASE PENDING IN A TRIAL
- 10 COURT OF THIS STATE, FOR 3 YEARS AFTER A JUDGMENT HAS BEEN
- 11 ENTERED IN THE CRIMINAL CASE.
