THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 10A. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), A
- 2 PERSON WHO HOLDS A CASINO LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL NOT
- 3 PERMIT AN INDIVIDUAL TO ENGAGE IN SMOKING IN A PUBLIC AREA OF A
- 4 CASINO.
- 5 (2) A PERSON WHO HOLDS A CASINO LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS
- 6 ACT MAY PERMIT AN INDIVIDUAL TO SMOKE IN 1 OR MORE DESIGNATED
- 7 AREAS THAT ENCOMPASS A TOTAL OF NOT MORE THAN 50% OF THE GAMING
- 8 AREA OF A CASINO.
- 9 (3) THE BOARD SHALL UTILIZE COMPLIANCE OR NONCOMPLIANCE WITH
- 10 THIS SECTION IN THE DETERMINATION OF WHETHER TO DENY, SUSPEND, OR
- 11 REVOKE A LICENSE UNDER SECTION 6.

- 2 (A) "PUBLIC AREA" MEANS THE ENCLOSED, INDOOR AREA OWNED OR
