

SENATE BILL No. 1315

June 20, 2000, Introduced by Senator JOHNSON and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms possessed in violation of this act; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act,"

(MCL 28.421 to 28.434) by adding section 15.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 15. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), A LOCAL
2 UNIT OF GOVERNMENT, A COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR A UNIVERSITY, OR THE
3 STATE SHALL NOT SELL OR OTHERWISE CONVEY A FIREARM TO ANY OTHER
4 PERSON.

5 (2) A FIREARM, OWNED BY OR UNDER THE CONTROL OF AN ENTITY IN
6 SUBSECTION (1), THAT IS NO LONGER USABLE AND THAT IS CONSIDERED
7 DISPOSABLE BY THAT ENTITY SHALL BE TURNED OVER TO THE DEPARTMENT

1 OF STATE POLICE FOR DISPOSITION IN THE SAME MANNER AS AUTHORIZED
2 UNDER SECTION 14.

3 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT"
4 MEANS A COUNTY, TOWNSHIP, CITY, OR VILLAGE OF THIS STATE.
