Senate Bill No. 334 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to restrict the number of passengers under 16 years old in a vehicle to the number of available seat belts and deletes the provisions allowing a child at least four years old to ride without a seat belt in the back seat if the number of passengers exceeds the number of seat belts.

By this amendment the number of civil infraction fines may increase. This number is indeterminate. There is no fiscal impact to the state, but there may be an indeterminate increase in costs and revenue to local units of government due to enforcement. The revenue from civil infraction fines benefits local libraries.
