House Bill 4765 (H-2) would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure with regard to certain proceedings pertaining to domestic violence, to allow hearsay evidence regarding domestic violence or threats of domestic violence. Certain conditions would have to be met in order for the evidence to be allowed. The bill would have no direct fiscal implications for the state or local units of government, although it could enable additional convictions to be obtained, which would tend to increase state or local correctional costs, depending on the offense in question.
