House Bill 5086 amends Article 9 of the Public Health Code regarding Supportive Personal Health Services. The bill adds Sec. 9171 to the Code to require the Department of Community Health (DCH) to develop and distribute to each school district, teacher, and school administrator in the state an informational pamphlet on psychotropic drugs frequently prescribed to minors, and their common side effects.

This bill has fiscal implications, which may be able to be accomplished within the existing resources and contracts which DCH has for health and educational publications and media purposes. DCH would incur costs to establish the correct information contained in the pamphlet and to design or contract for the design of the pamphlet. The cost to print and distribute 110,000 pamphlets created exclusively for this purpose, assuming a 25 cent cost per pamphlet, would total \$27,500.
