A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5489 AS INTRODUCED 12-11-01

House Bill 5489 would amend the Aeronautics Code to specify that the operator of a public use facility receiving a state or federal grant could not prohibit access to, or use of, an airport, unless the operator had failed to pay airport fees, or had failed to follow generally applied standards for airport use, or had violated a safety rule prescribed by the Aeronautics Commission, or the Federal Aviation Administration.
