## A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 6106 AS INTRODUCED 5-21-02

Under the Local Historic Districts Act, a local unit of government may establish a historic district containing historically significant buildings, sites, or features, after a review and recommendation by a local historic district study committee. House Bill 6106 would amend the act to specify that a historic district study committee could not recommend the establishment of a historic district unless each building, facility, or structure within the proposed district was equipped with a fire alarm system.
