**SUMMARY**

Senate Bill 439 would amend the Michigan Election Law to specify the dates upon which elections could be held in Michigan. Beginning January 1, 2003 the regular election dates would be: the fourth Tuesday in February; the first Tuesday after the first Monday in May; the first Tuesday after the first Monday in August; the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November. It would also require a special election to be held on a regular election day.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on State government but may have a small, yet indeterminate fiscal impact on local government.
