## **SUMMARY**

The School Aid Act allows districts to count up to two "snow" days--days during which a school district was closed due to snow or other conditions beyond its control--as instruction days. HB 4398 would allow districts to count any unused snow days from the previous three school years as instruction days in the current year, and subsequently receive state aid for those days. Currently, if a district is closed for more than two days per school year for snow or other reasons beyond its control, it makes those days up sometime before the end of the school year. This bill would alleviate the need to make those days up. It would have no state or local fiscal impact.
