- 5 AFTER THE DATE THE PRESCRIPTION IS WRITTEN.
- 6 (2) A prescription or AN equivalent record OF THE PRESCRIP-
- 7 TION APPROVED BY THE BOARD on file in a pharmacy OR IN THE OFFICE
- 8 OF A DISPENSING PRESCRIBER is not a public record. EXCEPT AS
- 9 OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), A PHARMACIST, PHARMACY
- 10 EMPLOYEE, DISPENSING PRESCRIBER, DISPENSING PRESCRIBER'S
- 11 EMPLOYEE, OR OTHER PERSON HAVING CUSTODY OF OR ACCESS TO A

- 24 scription shall cancel the original prescription and record the

- 16 ERS HAVE BEEN REMOVED BY CODING OR ENCRYPTION.
