HOUSE BILL NO. 4351

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law," by amending sections 560, 666, 706, and 777 (MCL 168.560, 168.666, 168.706, and 168.777), section 706 as amended by 2001 PA 269.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 560. (1) Such ballots THE OFFICIAL PRIMARY ELECTION
- 2 BALLOT shall contain the instructions as to the method of
- 3 voting.
- 4 (2) Ballots other than those furnished by the board of elec-
- 5 tion commissioners according to the provisions of this act
- 6 —, shall not be used, cast, or counted in any election precinct
- 7 at any such A primary election.

- 19 tion and shall furnish a A copy of the Michigan election law and
- 20 A COPY of the manual of instructions for each precinct board of

- 22 (b) Prior to each primary, general, or special election at
- 23 which state, district, or county officers are to be nominated or
- 24 elected, the secretary of state shall procure a supply of
- 25 self-sealing metal sealing devices adapted and suitable for seal-

- 1 serial numbers stamped thereon, and at least 30 days before any
- 2 such election he shall cause to be transmitted to the several
- 3 county clerks such number of said metal sealing devices as will

- 5 number of such seals SELF-SEALING METAL SEALING DEVICES for
- 6 each voting precinct within the county AT LEAST 30 DAYS
- 7 BEFORE AN ELECTION.
- 8 (c) The secretary of state shall furnish a A substantial
- 9 supply of red gummed paper seals for use of the precinct boards
- 10 of election inspectors in sealing -such THE package of ballots
- 11 and the envelopes containing the tally sheets or books and the
- 12 statement of returns. Each -such seal shall have inscribed
- 13 thereon ON IT the words "Election Seal--State of Michigan" and
- 14 the date of the primary or election at which it is to be used. A
- 15 space shall also be provided thereon ON THE SEAL in which 2
- 16 members of the board of election inspectors shall write their
- 17 initials after the seal has been applied. \rightarrow
- 18 (d) The secretary of state shall furnish uniform UNIFORM
- 19 printed instructions to electors printed in large type upon
- 20 cards PLACARDS, containing any information that will assist
- 21 electors in marking their ballots and correctly designating their
- 22 choices. Two -such OF THESE placards of instructions shall be
- 23 conspicuously displayed in each polling place. -; and AS APPLI-

- 5 IF YOU DO NOT UNDERSTAND THE BALLOT OR NEED ASSISTANCE, YOU
- 6 MAY ASK AN ELECTION OFFICIAL FOR ASSISTANCE. ELECTION OFFICIALS
- 7 ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE VOTERS WITH ASSISTANCE UPON REQUEST. IF
- 8 YOU BELIEVE YOU HAVE MADE A MISTAKE IN VOTING YOUR BALLOT, YOU
