- 5 COLLECTOR PLATE AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 811G. THE SECRETARY OF
- 6 STATE SHALL DESIGN THE PLATE, HAVING THE PINK RIBBON EMBLEM OF
- 7 THE SUSAN G. KOMEN BREAST CANCER FOUNDATION INSCRIBED ON THE
- 8 PLATE.
- 9 (2) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEPOSIT THE DONATION INTO
- 10 THE BREAST CANCER AWARENESS FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 217Q.
