

HOUSE BILL No. 4665

April 24, 2001, Introduced by Rep. Rocca and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 626c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 626C. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT DRIVE OR ATTEMPT TO DRIVE
2 A VEHICLE ON OR ACROSS A HIGHWAY THAT IS FLOODED DUE TO THE OVER-
3 FLOW OF A RIVER OR STREAM UNLESS THE DRIVER IS ABLE TO SEE THE
4 ROADBED AND THE SHOULDER ON 1 SIDE OF THE HIGHWAY. A PERSON
5 SHALL NOT DRIVE OR ATTEMPT TO DRIVE A VEHICLE ON OR ACROSS THE
6 ROADBED OF A BRIDGE THAT IS FLOODED DUE TO THE OVERFLOW OF A
7 RIVER OR STREAM.

8 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDE-
9 MEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS OR A
10 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$100.00, OR BOTH.
