THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 4W. THE TAX LEVIED UNDER THIS ACT DOES NOT APPLY TO
- 2 THE STORAGE, USE, OR CONSUMPTION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT WAS PUR-
- 3 CHASED OVERSEAS FOR TITLING AND REGISTRATION IN THIS STATE BY A
- 4 NONRESIDENT PERSON ACTUALLY SERVING IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED
- 5 FORCES WHO CLAIMS THIS STATE AS HIS OR HER HOME STATE OF RESI-
- 6 DENCY OR DOMICILE. TO CLAIM THIS EXEMPTION, THE PERSON SHALL
- 7 SUPPLY TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION A
- 8 SWORN STATEMENT FROM HIS OR HER IMMEDIATE COMMANDING OFFICER FUR-
- 9 NISHING THE RECORDED DOMICILIARY OR HOME ADDRESS OF THE PERSON
- 10 CLAIMING THE EXEMPTION AND CERTIFYING THAT THE PERSON CLAIMING
- 11 THE EXEMPTION IS A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES ON ACTIVE DUTY.
