A bill to amend 1986 PA 288, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan work-study program for qualified resident students attending eligible postsecondary schools and employed by qualified employers; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 390.1373).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. A recognized postsecondary school in this state is
- 2 eligible to participate in the MWS program if the postsecondary
- 3 school is a degree-granting institution approved by the state
- 4 board of education DEPARTMENT OF CAREER DEVELOPMENT, the
- 5 instructional programs are not comprised solely of sectarian
- 6 instruction or religious worship, and the school participates in
- 7 the federal work-study program under sections 441 to 448 of title
- 8 IV of the higher education act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. 2751 to 2756b.
