A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 136d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 136D. A PERSON AT THE SCENE OF AN EMERGENCY WHO KNOWS
- 2 THAT ANOTHER PERSON IS EXPOSED TO OR HAS SUFFERED GRAVE PHYSICAL
- 3 HARM SHALL, TO THE EXTENT THAT THE PERSON CAN DO SO WITHOUT
- 4 DANGER OR PERIL TO SELF OR OTHERS, GIVE REASONABLE ASSISTANCE TO
- 5 THAT PERSON. REASONABLE ASSISTANCE MAY INCLUDE OBTAINING OR
- 6 ATTEMPTING TO OBTAIN AID FROM LAW ENFORCEMENT OR MEDICAL
- 7 PERSONNEL. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 8 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS
- 9 OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$100.00, OR BOTH.
