by amending section 60 of chapter X (MCL 710.60), as amended by 1996 PA 409.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 CHAPTER X
- 2 Sec. 60. (1) After the entry of the AN order of adop-
- 3 tion, the adoptee shall, in case of a change of name, be known
- 4 and called by the new name. The person or persons AFTER ENTRY
- 5 OF THE ORDER, AN INDIVIDUAL adopting the adoptee then stand
- 6 STANDS in the place of a parent or parents to the adoptee in
- 7 law in all respects as though the adopted person INDIVIDUAL had
- 8 been born to the adopting parents and are PARENT AND IS liable

- 3 (2) After entry of the AN order of adoption, there is no
- 4 distinction between the rights and duties of natural progeny and
