

SENATE BILL No. 1364

May 29, 2002, Introduced by Senators HOFFMAN and MC COTTER and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled
"The code of criminal procedure,"
(MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 4a to chapter IV.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER IV

SEC. 4A. (1) THE FUGITIVE TRANSPORT ASSESSMENT FUND IS CRE-

3

ATED AS A SEPARATE FUND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY. THE STATE

4

TREASURER SHALL CREDIT THE MONEY RECEIVED FROM THE COURT FOR BAIL

5

FORFEITED UNDER SECTION 4 OF THIS CHAPTER AND ANY OTHER MONEY

6

RECEIVED FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,

7

MONEY RECEIVED AS PROVIDED BY LAW, TO THE FUGITIVE TRANSPORT

8

ASSESSMENT FUND. FUNDS FROM THE FUGITIVE TRANSPORT ASSESSMENT

9

FUND SHALL BE EXPENDED ONLY AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

1 (2) MONEY CREDITED TO THE FUGITIVE TRANSPORT ASSESSMENT FUND
2 SHALL BE PAID OUT BY THE STATE TREASURER FOR THE FOLLOWING
3 PURPOSES:

4 (A) MATCHING GRANTS APPROVED BY THE FUGITIVE TRANSPORT
5 ASSESSMENT FUND PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 4B OF THIS
6 CHAPTER.

7 (B) ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
8 START-UP COSTS, ASSOCIATED WITH CONDUCTING THE FUGITIVE TRANSPORT
9 ASSESSMENT FUND PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 4B OF THIS
10 CHAPTER.
