

# SENATE BILL No. 1403

September 17, 2002, Introduced by Senators HOFFMAN and BULLARD and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1929 PA 152, entitled

"An act to provide for the state-owned and operated Michigan public safety communications system for police and public safety purposes; to provide for acquisition, construction, implementation, operation, and maintenance of the property and equipment necessary to operate the system; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 28.283), as amended by 1996 PA 538.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 3. (1) The department of state police shall broadcast  
2 all police dispatches and reports which have a reasonable rela-  
3 tion to or connection with the apprehension of criminals, the  
4 prevention of crime, or the maintenance of peace, order, and  
5 public safety in this state.

6       (2) ~~The~~ SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (4), THE director of the  
7 department of state police ~~may authorize~~ SHALL ALLOW any  
8 governmental public safety agency to utilize the Michigan public

1 safety communications system INCLUDING ATTACHING PUBLIC SAFETY  
2 COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT TO TOWERS CONSTRUCTED UNDER THIS ACT.

3 (3) ALL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE  
4 OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCY EQUIPMENT SHALL BE THE  
5 RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCY  
6 REQUESTING PERMISSION.

7 (4) THE DIRECTOR MAY DENY PERMISSION TO INSTALL OR ATTACH  
8 LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL PUBLIC SAFETY EQUIPMENT TO A TOWER CONSTRUCTED  
9 UNDER THIS ACT IF THE INSTALLATION OR ATTACHMENT WILL INTERFERE  
10 WITH THE OPTIMUM OPERATION OF THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNI-  
11 CATION SYSTEM AS DETERMINED BY THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC SAFETY COMMU-  
12 NICATIONS SYSTEM ADVISORY BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION  
13 TECHNOLOGY.
