**Analysis**                            **Summary**  
This bill would create a regional water and sewer authority, and establish procedures governing the review of services contracts for Detroit's water and sewer systems. Any contract exceeding \$50,000 or contract overrun would be subject to authority approval. HB 4206 would require the City to establish an ethics manual for system business as well.

**Fiscal Impact**

These bills would have an indeterminate fiscal impact on the City of Detroit. The actual impact would depend on the administrative costs of the required contract reviews, and on the number and nature of contracts and contract overruns reviewed by the authority.

There would be no fiscal impact on State Government
