Summary

Senate Bill 224 would designate the fourth Friday in April of each year as “Children’s Memorial Day” in recognition of the number of tragic deaths of children of all ages from all causes that occur each year. The bill would encourage individuals, educational institutions, and social, community, religious, labor, and business organizations to pause on Children’s Memorial Day and reflect upon the resource that children constitute and the loss we suffer when we lose them.

Senate Bill 224 would have no fiscal impact on state or local units of government.
