Analysis

Summary

The bill would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to require the Michigan Secretary of State to develop and issue a "Cancer Awareness" fund-raising license plate, and matching collector plate. The bill would also create a "Cancer Awareness" fund within the state treasury. Funds from \$25 fund-raising donations would be credited to the Cancer Awareness Fund. The bill would require the state treasurer to disburse money in the fund, on a quarterly basis, one-third to the Michigan Chapter of the American Cancer Society, one-third to the Barbara Ann Karmonos Cancer Institute, and one-third to the Hospice of Michigan.

The H-2 substitute includes a tie-bar to SB 785.

Fiscal Impact

The Michigan Department of State estimates that initial start-up costs for a new fund-raising plate are approximately \$15,000. These costs would be recovered under provisions of SB 785. For a more detailed analysis of the fund-raising plate program, see the House Fiscal Agency analysis of Senate Bill 785.
