Analysis **Summary**
House Bill (HB) 5358 would amend the General Property Tax Act to specify that the State Tax Commission would be required to certify a person as a qualified personal property examiner if it determined that the applicant had sufficient education and experience and if the applicant passed a commission-conducted examination.

Fiscal Impact
House Bill 5358 specifies that the cost of an examination shall be on a per assessment parcel fixed fee basis and shall not exceed the actual cost of providing the examination. This bill would have no State fiscal impact.
