## REMOVE MANUFACTURERS FROM SIGN SPECIALTY LICENSURE

## A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5349 AS INTRODUCED 12-23-03

The Electrical Administrative Act requires the licensure of electric "sign specialists" and "sign specialty contractors". The act defines a sign specialty contractor as a person, firm, or corporation engaged in the business of manufacturing, installing, maintaining, connecting, or repairing electric sign wiring or devices. <u>House Bill 5349</u> would remove the word "manufacturing" from this definition.

The act lists the licensing criteria for a person to meet in obtaining a sign specialist's license, including a specified amount of experience in the manufacture, installation, maintenance, connection, or repair of electric signs and related wiring. The bill would remove the word "manufacture" from this provision as well.
