## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

sec. 3109. (1) Benefits provided or required to be provided
under the laws of any state or the federal government shall be
subtracted from the personal protection insurance benefits
otherwise payable for the injury.

(2) An injured person is a natural person suffering
accidental bodily injury.

(3) An insurer providing personal protection insurance
benefits may offer, at appropriately reduced premium rates, a
deductible of a specified dollar amount which does not exceed
$300.00 per accident. This deductible may be applicable to all
or any specified types of personal protection insurance benefits
```
