## **HOUSE BILL No. 5623**

February 26, 2004, Introduced by Reps. Tobocman, Hunter and Meisner and referred to the Committee on Land Use and Environment.

A bill to amend 1921 PA 207, entitled "City and village zoning act," by amending section 3a (MCL 125.583a).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 (1) The lawful use of land or a structure exactly Sec. 3a.
- as the land or structure existed at the time of the enactment of
- the zoning ordinance affecting that land or structure, may be 3
- continued, except as otherwise provided in this act, although
- 5 that use or structure does not conform with the ordinance.
- (2) The -legislative body zoning ordinance may provide -by
  - ordinance for the resumption, restoration, reconstruction,
- extension, or substitution of nonconforming uses or structures

- 1 or structures or for the termination or removal of nonconforming

- 22 213.41 of the Michigan Compiled Laws uniform condemnation
- 23 procedures act, 1980 PA 87, MCL 213.51 to 213.75, or any other
- 24 applicable -statute law.
