## **HOUSE BILL No. 6160**

September 9, 2004, Introduced by Reps. Koetje, Tabor and Farhat and referred to the Committee on Conservation and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 30112 (MCL 324.30112), as added by 1995 PA 59.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

(1) The department may commence a civil action

- in the circuit court of the county in which a violation occurs to enforce compliance with this part, to restrain violation of this part or any action contrary to an order of the department denying a permit, or to enjoin the further performance of —, or order the removal of,— any project that is undertaken contrary to this part or after denial of a permit by the department. —, or to order the restoration of the affected area to its prior condition.
  - (2) In a civil action commenced under this part, the circuit court, in addition to any other relief granted, may assess a

- 1 civil fine of not more than \$5,000.00 per day for each day of

- 3 (3) Except as provided in subsection -(4) (5), a person who

- 24 (6) —(5)— A person who knowingly makes a false statement,
- 25 representation, or certification in an application for a permit
- 26 or in a notice or report required by a permit, or a person who
- 27 knowingly renders inaccurate any monitoring device or method
