

# HOUSE BILL No. 6355

November 10, 2004, Introduced by Reps. Meisner, Law, Gillard and Tobocman and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
by amending section 430a (MCL 750.430a), as added by 1998 PA  
110.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 430a. (1) An individual shall not intentionally engage  
2 in or attempt to engage in human cloning.

3       (2) Subsection (1) does not prohibit scientific research or  
4 cell-based therapies not specifically prohibited by that  
5 subsection.

6       (3) An individual who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a  
7 felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than ~~10~~ 15 years  
8 or a fine of not more than \$10,000,000.00, or both.

9       (4) As used in this section, "human cloning" means that term  
10 as defined in section 16274 of the public health code, 1978 PA

1 368, MCL 333.16274.

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take  
3 effect unless all of the following bills of the 92nd Legislature  
4 are enacted into law:
