SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4559

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 9721.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 9721. (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL
- 2 SHALL CREATE AND OPERATE A PRESCRIPTION DRUG WEBSITE TO EDUCATE
- 3 CONSUMERS ABOUT THE PRICE OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS AND TO PROVIDE
- 4 LINKS TO OTHER HELPFUL WEBSITES INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
- 5 THOSE WEBSITES THAT MAY ASSIST AND EDUCATE CONSUMERS ON THE
- 6 AVAILABILITY OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROGRAMS THAT OFFER ACCESS TO
- 7 DISCOUNTED OR FREE PRESCRIPTION DRUGS IN COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL
- 8 AND STATE RULES AND REGULATIONS.
- 9 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL, IN CONSULTATION WITH

- 1 THE DEPARTMENT, SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ON THE
- 2 PRESCRIPTION DRUG WEBSITE:
- 3 (A) A LIST OF THE 25 MOST COMMONLY PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS AS
- 4 REPORTED BY THIS STATE'S MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
- 5 (B) THE USUAL AND CUSTOMARY PRICE OF THE 25 MOST COMMONLY
- 6 PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS IDENTIFIED UNDER SUBDIVISION (A).
- 7 (C) A MINIMUM OF 5 LINKS TO OTHER WEBSITES AS DESCRIBED IN
- 8 SUBSECTION (1).
- 9 (D) THE DEPARTMENT'S TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE NUMBER CREATED UNDER
- 10 SECTION 9723.
- 11 (3) THE DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL HAS THE SOLE DISCRETION
- 12 OF AUTHORITY TO DETERMINE WHICH INFORMATION SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE
- 13 TO THE PUBLIC THROUGH THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG WEBSITE CREATED
- 14 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.
- 15 (4) AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL OBTAIN FROM
- 16 THE PERSON THAT THE DEPARTMENT HAS CONTRACTED TO SERVE AS ITS
- 17 PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER FOR THIS STATE'S MEDICAL ASSISTANCE
- 18 PROGRAM THE USUAL AND CUSTOMARY DRUG PRICE AS REPORTED FOR THE 25
- 19 MOST COMMONLY PRESCRIBED DRUGS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION
- 20 (2)(A) TO THAT PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER BY EACH PHARMACY THAT
- 21 FILLS OR REFILLS A PRESCRIPTION UNDER THIS STATE'S MEDICAL
- 22 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 23 ATTORNEY GENERAL WITH A COPY, WRITTEN OR ELECTRONIC, OF THIS
- 24 INFORMATION. FROM THE INFORMATION OBTAINED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION,
- 25 THE DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL ONLY INCLUDE ON ITS
- 26 WEBSITE THE USUAL AND CUSTOMARY PRICE OF THE 25 MOST COMMONLY
- 27 PRESCRIBED DRUGS FROM ALL PHARMACIES THAT HAVE FILLED OR REFILLED A

- PRESCRIPTION UNDER THIS STATE'S MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. 1
- 2 (5) SUBSECTION (4) DOES NOT REQUIRE A PHARMACY THAT FILLS OR
- 3 REFILLS A PRESCRIPTION UNDER THIS STATE'S MEDICAL ASSISTANCE
- 4 PROGRAM TO PROVIDE ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAN THAT CURRENTLY
- 5 BEING REPORTED BY THE PHARMACY TO THE PERSON THAT THE DEPARTMENT
- HAS CONTRACTED TO SERVE AS ITS PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER FOR THIS 6
- STATE'S MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. 7
- (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "USUAL AND CUSTOMARY PRICE" MEANS 8
- 9 THAT PRICE THAT IS COMPARABLE TO WHAT A PHARMACY WOULD CHARGE A
- 10 CASH-PAYING CUSTOMER WITHOUT INSURANCE. USUAL AND CUSTOMARY PRICE
- 11 DOES NOT INCLUDE DISCOUNTS, SPECIAL PROMOTIONS, OR OTHER PROGRAMS
- 12 INITIATED TO REDUCE PRICES FOR PRODUCT COSTS AVAILABLE TO THE
- GENERAL PUBLIC OR TO A SPECIAL POPULATION. 13
