## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 32. (1) There is hereby continued in IN the office of
- 2 the secretary of state, the bureau of elections created by Act No.
- 3 65 of the Public Acts of 1951, FORMER 1951 PA 65 CONTINUES under
- 4 the supervision of a director of elections, to be appointed by the
- 5 secretary of state under civil service regulations. The director of
- 6 elections shall be vested with the powers and shall perform the
- 7 duties of the secretary of state under his OR HER supervision, with
- 8 respect to the supervision and administration of the election laws.

- 1 The director of elections shall be a nonmember secretary of the

- 3 (2) The director of elections -, with the approval of the
