

HOUSE BILL No. 4103

February 1, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Wojno, Byrnes, Accavitti, Hood, Gonzales, Sak, Miller, Gleason and Plakas and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," (MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 20195a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 20195A. (1) A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY IN WHICH INVASIVE
2 SURGICAL PROCEDURES ARE PERFORMED AND IN WHICH THE EMPLOYEES ARE
3 ROUTINELY EXPOSED TO BLOOD OR OTHER POTENTIALLY INFECTIOUS MATERIAL
4 OR ROUTINELY REQUIRED TO ENTER RESTRICTED OPERATING AREAS SHALL
5 COMPLY WITH THE LAUNDERING REQUIREMENTS OF R 325.70011 OF THE
6 MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE. A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY DESCRIBED
7 IN THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT ALLOW OR REQUIRE AN EMPLOYEE WHO
8 PARTICIPATES IN INVASIVE SURGICAL PROCEDURES, HAS EXPOSURE TO BLOOD

1 OR OTHER POTENTIALLY INFECTIOUS MATERIAL, OR ENTERS A RESTRICTED
2 OPERATING AREA TO TAKE HIS OR HER WORK CLOTHES HOME FOR LAUNDERING.

3 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "OTHER POTENTIALLY INFECTIOUS
4 MATERIAL" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN R 325.70002 OF THE MICHIGAN
5 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.
