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## **HOUSE BILL No. 4504**

March 16, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Wojno, Accavitti, Sak, Whitmer, Gillard, Byrnes, Marleau and Lemmons, III and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 21525.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 21525. (1) BEFORE FEBRUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, EACH HOSPITAL
- 2 SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT SUMMARIZING THE NUMBER OF
- 3 HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS CONTRACTED BY PATIENTS IN THE
- 4 IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR. THE ANNUAL REPORT OF HOSPITAL-
- 5 ACQUIRED INFECTIONS SHALL BE SUBMITTED ON A FORM AND IN A MANNER AS
- 6 PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE ANY
- 7 INFORMATION CONSIDERED NECESSARY FOR THE SURVEILLANCE, CONTROL, AND
  - PREVENTION OF HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS.
- 9 (2) THE REPORTING FORM SHALL BREAK DOWN THE NUMBER OF
- 10 HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS CONTRACTED BY PATIENTS WITHIN EACH

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- 1 UNIT OR DEPARTMENT WITHIN THE HOSPITAL. THE REPORTING FORM SHALL
- 2 NOT CONTAIN THE NAME OF THE PATIENTS, COMMON IDENTIFIERS SUCH AS
- 3 SOCIAL SECURITY OR DRIVER LICENSE NUMBERS, OR OTHER INFORMATION
- 4 IDENTIFIERS THAT WOULD MAKE IT POSSIBLE TO IDENTIFY IN ANY MANNER
- 5 OR IN ANY CIRCUMSTANCES THE PATIENT.
- 6 (3) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE RULES TO PROVIDE FOR THE
- 7 STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES FOR THE COLLECTION, ANALYSIS, AND
- 8 REPORTING OF HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS UNDER THIS SECTION AND
- 9 PRESERVATION OF THE ANONYMITY OF EACH PATIENT WHILE REPORTING THE
- 10 NUMBER OF HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT.
- 11 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTION"
- 12 MEANS A NOSOCOMIAL INFECTION THAT IS A LOCALIZED OR SYSTEMIC
- 13 CONDITION RESULTING FROM AN ADVERSE REACTION TO THE PRESENCE OF AN
- 14 INFECTIOUS AGENT OR ITS TOXIN AND THAT WAS NOT PRESENT OR
- 15 INCUBATING AT THE TIME A PATIENT WAS ADMITTED TO THE HOSPITAL FOR
- 16 MEDICAL TREATMENT.
