

# HOUSE BILL No. 4744

May 5, 2005, Introduced by Reps. McConico and Phillips and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
by amending section 170 (MCL 750.170).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 170. (1) ~~Disturbance of lawful meetings—Any~~ A person  
2 ~~who~~ shall **NOT** make or excite any disturbance or contention in **OR**  
3 **AT** any **OF THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:**

4       (A) A tavern. —

5       (B) A store or grocery. —

6       (C) A manufacturing establishment or any other business place.

8       (D) A street, lane, alley, **OR** highway. —

9       (E) A public building, **PUBLIC** grounds, or **A PUBLIC** park. —~~or~~

2 (F) AN election or other public meeting where ~~citizens~~  
3 INDIVIDUALS are peaceably and lawfully assembled. ~~, shall be~~

4 (G) A STADIUM, COLISEUM, ARENA, OR ANY OTHER PLACE WHERE  
5 INDIVIDUALS ARE GATHERED FOR A SPORTING EVENT.

6 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS guilty of a  
7 misdemeanor PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 93 DAYS OR  
8 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.

9 (3) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A PERSON FROM BEING CHARGED  
10 WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR PUNISHED FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION OF LAW  
11 COMMITTED BY THAT PERSON WHILE VIOLATING OR ATTEMPTING TO VIOLATE  
12 THIS SECTION.
