August 24, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Caswell and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 303a (MCL 750.303a), as added by 1996 PA 539.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 303a. This chapter does not apply to recreational CARD
- 2 PLAYING IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 3 (A) THE card playing IS conducted at a senior citizen CENTER,
- 4 CLUB, GROUP, OR housing facility not licensed by the liquor control
- 5 commission.

 - PARTICIPATE IN ACTIVITIES AT THE SENIOR CITIZEN CENTER, MEMBERS OF
 - THE senior citizens club or -a group, -of OR residents of -a THE

- 1 (C) THE CLUB OR GROUP CONDUCTING THE CARD PLAYING consists of
- 2 at least 15 members who are 60 years of age or older. -under all of

- 5 amusement and recreation of the members and guests of the club or
- 6 group and is not conducted for fund-raising. The number of guests

- 21 participating in the conduct of CONDUCTING the card playing.
